



Earth Immersion Camp Packing List

Packing List

- \$200 Emergency Money which will be held by staff and given back at end of camp if not used.
- Spending \$ for snacks during convenience store visits and souvenirs/T-shirts at dive sites (most campers spend around \$75)
- If flying to/from camp, \$ for checked bag and unaccompanied minor fees for return flight. We can keep this with the emergency \$ so that your child doesn't accidentally spend it.
- Clothing for a minimum of one week (laundry facilities available on-site)
- Toiletry Items & Toiletry Bag
- 2 Towels (avoid beach towel size) and Washcloth
- Swimsuit(s)
- Sunscreen
- Bug Spray
- Closed Toed Shoes for light hiking (athletic shoes are fine)
- Sandals
- Raincoat
- Water Bottle
- Sleeping Bag (fitted sheet for mattress is provided)
- Pillow
- Dirty Clothes Bag
- Medications (if applicable)
- Small Backpack/Daypack
- Headlamp or small flashlight
- Camera (campers will not have their phones)
- Snacks with name on them (We provide daily snacks but you are welcome to bring non-refrigerated favorites. Absolutely no gum or candy)
- COVID-19 Pre-Screening Questionnaire signed by parent/guardian and camper
- Completed, corrected originals of all paperwork
- 2 -3 reusable/washable face masks or enough disposable face masks for each day
- Wetsuit & Booties
- Any other dive equipment that you own: mask, fins, snorkel, log book, BCD, regulators, dive computer, dive light, surface marker buoy, spool, compass, Z-knife. If you don't own any of this, skip this. The complementary scuba equipment package that you ordered will be handed out at camp.

For 13-day sessions only:

- Fishing rod & reel, tackle (Optional – for canoe trip)
- Drybag 20L minimum (Optional – for canoe trip) – One will be provided if camper does not bring one
- Hammock or Sleeping Pad (Optional – for camping while on the canoe trip, must be able to roll up like a Thermarest pad) – Sleeping Pad will be provided if camper does not bring one.

Do Not Bring:

- Laptops, iPads, smart watches, headphones, or any other electronics
- Knives or multitools (including dive knives), Diving Z-knives acceptable
- Absolutely no gum or candy
